## ITEMS TO PACK

- If you have not mailed your completed health form to the camp site 2 weeks prior to the camp start date, you **MUST** bring it with you. You do need to have a health form on file for each member of your family.
- Any medications should be in original containers and clearly labeled AND recorded on your health forms.
- Warm sleeping bag or bedding and pillow
- Towels/washcloths
- Closed-toe shoes/sneakers with socks preferred
- Warm jacket and/or sweater
- Camp clothes (for both warm and cool weather)
- Long-sleeved shirt and one pair of long pants
- Bible
- Pencil/paper/flashlight (new batteries)
- Rain gear
- Insect repellent/sunscreen
- Swimsuit (modest)/beach towel
- Water shoes or other tight fitting footwear
- Toothbrush/toothpaste/soap/deodorant/etc.
- Re-usable water bottle

## HEALTH FORM INFO

Every camper must have a completed health form on file with us before attending camp.

**Adults** need to complete the Adult Health Record Form.

**Youth under 18** need to complete the Camp Health Form. If they are attending with their parent or legal guardian they may waive section H (medical examination) of the youth health form, but all other sections (A through G, I and J) are required for all attendees.

Completed health forms need to be provided annually.

**Send your completed health form directly to the camp site 2 weeks prior to your camp start date.**

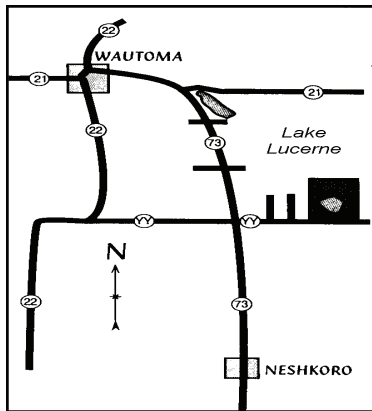
**Please DO NOT** send the health form to the Sun Prairie Camping Office.

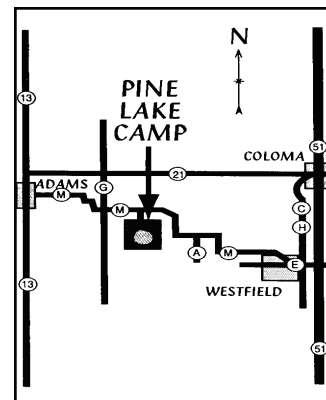

Pine Lake Camp is located 7 miles northwest of Westfield. Exit Hwy 39/51 at Westfield and go west on Cty E. Take Pioneer Park Road to the right (first right after going under the I-39 overpass). At the first stop sign, turn north (right) on Cty M/CH. About 3/4 mile north of the stop sign, Cty M turns west. Follow Cty M for 7 miles to Pine Lake Camp.
