## ITEMS TO PACK

- If you have not mailed your completed health form to the camp site 2 weeks prior to the camp start date, you **MUST** bring it with you.
- Any medications should be in original containers and clearly labeled to turn in to the Camp Nurse.
- Warm sleeping bag or bedding and pillow
- Towels/washcloths
- Closed-toe shoes/sneakers with socks preferred
- Warm jacket and/or sweater
- Camp clothes (for both warm and cool weather)
- Long-sleeved shirt and one pair of long pants
- Bible
- Pencil/paper/flashlight (new batteries)
- Rain gear
- Insect repellent/sunscreen
- Swimsuit (modest)/beach towel
- Water shoes or other tight fitting footwear
- Toothbrush/toothpaste/soap/deodorant/etc.
- Re-usable water bottle

## LEAVE IT HOME

Please do not bring candy, gum, snack foods, hair dryers or curling irons, radios, CD players, iPods, electronic games, or comic books. We cannot be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of personal items.

### Leave cell phones at home!

With increased technology that may infringe on the privacy of our campers, we will not allow cell phones to remain with campers. If the camper has a problem requiring phone usage, as always, she/he should tell a responsible adult who will phone the camper's home.

## STARTING/ENDING TIMES

Information concerning the starting and ending times of your camp is provided in your camper confirmation letter. You may want to verify the indicated times with the Event Director.

### \*\*\* IMPORTANT! \*\*\* HEALTH FORM INFO

The Board of Camp and Retreat Ministries Camping Committee requires that campers have a medical exam performed by a physician, physician's assistant, or registered nurse within the 24 months prior to the camp start date. Every camper must have a completed health form on file with us before attending camp. Along with the medical examination, the form addresses allergies, dietary restrictions, pick-up authorization, medication authorization, etc. Completed health forms need to be provided annually.

**Send your completed health form directly to the camp site 2 weeks prior to your camp start date.**

**Please DO NOT** send the health form to the Camping Office in Sun Prairie.

## SCHOLARSHIPS

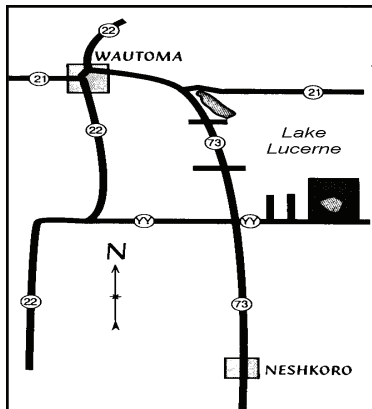
Have you inquired about camp scholarships? Many United Methodist Churches have scholarship funds designated to be used for camping. Please contact your local United Methodist Church.

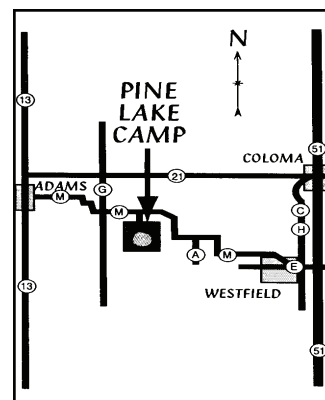
