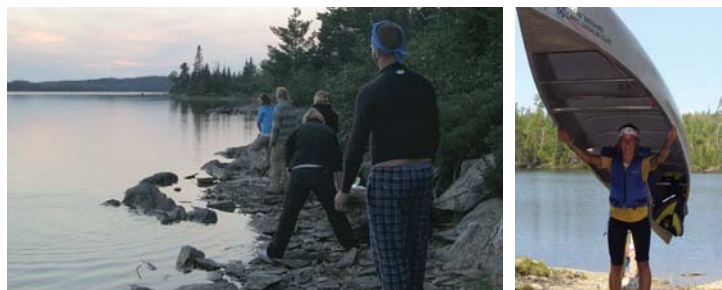


### Catch the Boundary Waters Spirit
