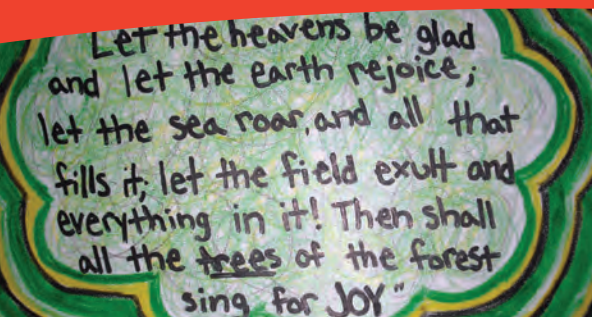
Special Needs

Stewardship Retreat

(Adult)

“Live, Give, Love” is the theme for our life together in the Wisconsin Annual Conference in 2012, and the name of the conference-wide annual financial stewardship campaign being unveiled at the fifth annual Stewardship Retreat at Pine Lake Camp, August 16-18. This 30 hour retreat is co-sponsored by the Wisconsin United Methodist Foundation, the Board of Camp and Retreat Ministries, and the Stewardship Resource Team of the annual conference.

The primary focus of this year’s retreat is developing a 3-5 year stewardship ministry plan incorporating the conference-wide **Live, Give, Love** giving campaign to be held in the fall of 2012. Clergy and laity are encouraged, but not required, to attend as a team to learn how to run the **Live, Give, Love** campaign in your congregation. Resources from the Foundation, including a summary of stewardship resources from the Foundation library will also be shared. Workshops will include:

- What types of financial stewardship programs are available and when is it best to use a particular program?
- Technology and Giving ... how can we best use technology to invite people to grow in their generosity?
- How to write a Narrative Budget.
- **Freed Up From Debt** – a comprehensive, 2-hour plan to help you get out and stay out of debt forever!
- How to respond to different types of givers/members

A new workshop this year will be **How can I possibly make financial visits to members of our congregation?** The principles of financial stewardship will be discussed in a casual, retreat setting with time devoted to developing a stewardship ministry plan for your individual church or charge. We begin Thursday with lunch and end by 5:00 pm Friday. Cost is \$40 for double occupancy, \$80 for single occupancy. (The camp fee is subsidized by a Conference scholarship) Leaders include Rev. Jean Ehnert Nicholas, Rev. George Kafer, Rev. Dan Dick and Lenore Geisthardt.
