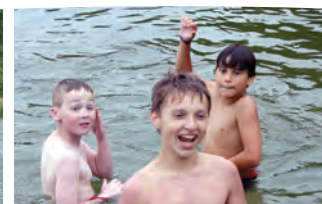
FAMILY CAMPS
