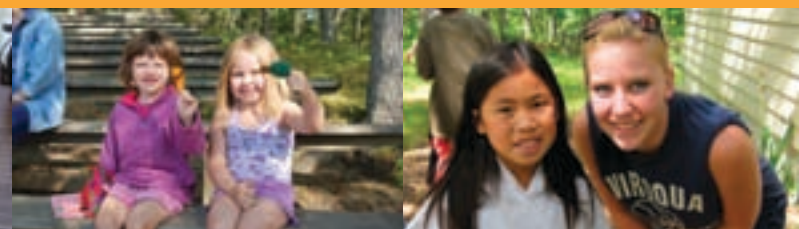
NATIVE AMERICAN EXPERIENCE
