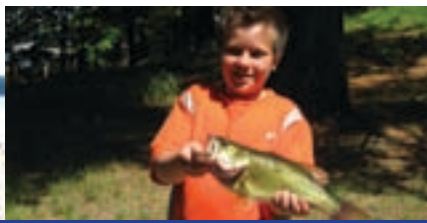


FAMILY CAMPS

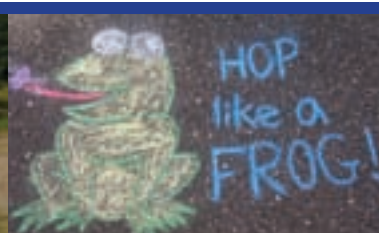
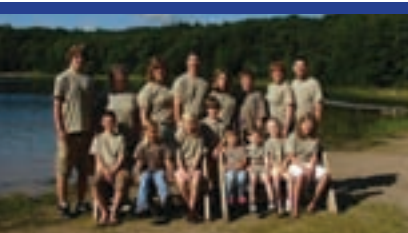

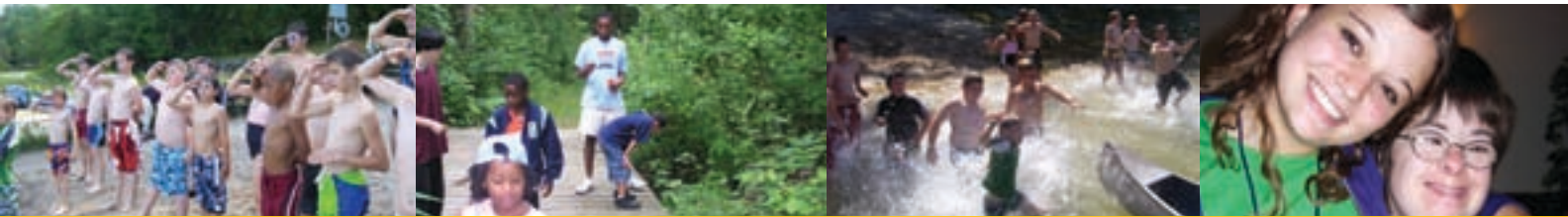
BOBBIN' FOR FISH
